

Easy To Grow Plants



Easy to grow Perennials

These plants are less troubled by diseases and can cope with sun or shade and different soils.
They are also quite well behaved unlike some plants which will take over your garden.
Most have a fairly long flowering period.

Alchemilla mollis – self seeds – lovely foliage

Aquilegia – cut back for second flush

Astrantia major – self seeds

Bergenia – evergreen

Crocsmia – forms clumps

Dicentra – pretty flowers

Fuchsia (choose a hardy variety)

Gaura – late flowering

Hardy Geranium – lots of different varieties

Helenium – tall and late flowering

Hosta – grown for foliage

Penstemon – long flowering

Phlox – long flowering

Pulmonaria – early flowering ground cover

Salvia (choose a hardy variety)

Verbena – self seeds. Verbena Bonariensis is very tall – stunning

Not forgetting of course, forget-me-nots and primroses!
